

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting

June 1, 2026 – 6:00 p.m.

The Following board members answered Roll Call Trustee Randy Kuhn, Trustee William McKinney, and Fiscal Officer Steve Welter.

Guests: Jeff Hohman, Dennis Kingseed, Andy Kimmet, Chris Hafley, Dennis Wilksens, and Ray Bishop.

Trustee Kuhn asked everyone to recite the pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on May 18th, 2026 were read and approved.

The minutes of the Special meeting held on May 28th, 2026 were read and approved.

Correspondence

The township received a driveway permit to be reviewed. The township also received a letter from Seneca East Public Library inviting the township to participate in a time capsule project. The township received another bill from ATT for the old land lines. Fiscal Officer Welter reported that he wrote a letter explaining that these lines were canceled in December and the township is still being billed. Fiscal officer Welter put the letter in with the bill and returned it. The township received the signed certified letter receipt that Jamie Bauman received her letter about the property on Township Rd 122 and the debris piling up. Fiscal Officer Welter reported receiving a text from Mrs. Kagy with Tom Gibson copied about Tom Gibson and Tillies not putting a no parking sign up that he is required to do for the conditional use and several people turning around in her driveway. Thirty minutes later Fiscal Officer Welter received a txt from Tom Gibson with a picture of a broken No turn around sign with a note that said it was mysteriously broken. The township received an email from Doug Wilhelm about putting in an entrance to his field. He said he spoke to one of the township employees about six weeks ago and he was going to look into it and get back to him and never did. Road worker Andy said he did talk to him and told him he needed to go and buy a twenty foot section of 8-inch tile and he would install it. Road worker Andy said Mr. Wilhelm did not tell him it was going to be an entrance to a field. He just said he was extending the tile. Fiscal Officer Welter asked if he needed to get a permit for that. Zoning inspector Hohman said he needed to get a permit to extend a tile that he wanted extended. Fiscal Officer Welter said he would respond to the email.

Dennis Wilkson reported that Eden Township passed the Ohio Building Codes and the Ohio Fire Code so they are good to make inspections for the area they cover. Mr. Wilkson also reported that the shrubs on Siesta drive need trimming. He said your asking for an accident there. Road Worker Andy said that is at the corner of a State Route. He will contact the State.

Chief Hafley reported that year to date we are at 272 runs last year at this time were at 208 up 64 runs. 16 fire calls 221 medical 17 accidents 11 service calls. Chief Hafley reported that

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they have received resignations from Alex Kear, and Van Williams and they have received both of their gear back. Chief Hafley reported that they will be having another firefighter resign because he is moving out of the area but he has not turned in his letter as of yet.

Zoning inspector Hohman reported that he sent a certified letter to 114 Techumseh Trail about the buildings that need to be moved. Zone Inspector Hohman asked how do we determine what Mr. Stockner stated was correct. Fiscal Officer Welter said we should check with Derek Devine or Ellie Anderson in the prosecutors office. Bob Reinhart said he suggests that if you ever have a meeting that you think is possible going to be controversial you can ask one of the lawyers to come from the prosecutor's office.

Road worker Andy reported that Hawk got started on River Road trimming the trees. He would be back Wednesday to finish.

Trustee McKinney said that the program through the gas company has been discontinued. Trustee McKinney said that when they did their road inspections Township Road 201 needed some trimming. Hawk said he would not be about to get to it until after school starts. Trustee McKinney said he would check with Cliff and if he does not EZ Tree Services might be interested in doing it. Trustee McKinney said he would call Cliff and if he does not want to do it, He would call EZ Tree Service.

Trustee Kuhn asked about the \$3000.00 purchase order for Utilities. Fiscal Officer Welter explained that it was a blanket purchase order for the year so we can pay multiple utilities without having to do a purchase order for every single invoice.

Trustee McKinney asked if Fiscal Officer Welter was going to reach out to the prosecutors office about the Special Meeting. Fiscal Officer Welter said that he would contact the prosecutors office about the meeting.

Discussion was held on issue one projects for next year how the process works.
