

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting

June 15, 2026 – 6:00 p.m.

The Following board members answered Roll Call Trustee Randy Kuhn, Trustee Jim Distel, Trustee William McKinney, and Fiscal Officer Steve Welter.

Guests: Jeff Hohman, Dennis Kingseed, Andy Kimmet, Chris Hafley, Dennis Wilksens, and Ray Bishop.

Trustee Kuhn asked everyone to recite the pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on June 1st, 2026 were read and approved.

Correspondence

Fiscal Officer Welter reported receiving a driveway permit. It was approved by the Trustees. Received an email from a Tim Peiffer about a pot hole forming in front of the entrance of Tr 1177. Road Worker Andy went out and filled it. He reported that it is actually on County Road 19 so they should contact the county if it forms again. Received a letter from Maple Grover Materials with latest Pricing. Received an E-mail from Adam Gilmore about the Seneca county Fair Booth. Received an email from Judy Deze about Ohio Public Works Round 41 with instructions. Received an email from Derek Devine stating he would meet with the Trustees.

Chief Hafley reported that for 2026 year to date total they had 307 calls for service. May break down is 3 fire calls 40 medicals calls 3 accidents 1 call for service. Year to date 17 fire calls mutual aid 7 medical 248 motor vehicle crashes 20 services calls were 15. Year to date this year we are at 307 calls last year at this time 189 an increase of 48%. Chief Hafley reported that they did receive the Ohio Fire Marshal's grant that they are going to purchase a new tic unit on 32. They are going to purchase some helmets to go with the grain tub.

Zoning inspector Hohman reported that 114 Techumseh has removed the buildings in question and are in compliance as of now.

Road worker Andy reported that he did talk to ODOT about the shrubs on Siesta Drive and State Route 231 and they put it on their list. The Drive way permit for 165 has been taken care of. Road worker Andy reported talking to Cliff Adams of Tiffin Tree Service and he said he could work for two days at 160 per hour on Township Road 201. Road worker Andy reported that Hawk Tree Service did finish with Township Road 73 north of 130 this morning so he has started on 73 is now going south of Township Road 130. Trustee Distel asked if he has been billing us. Fiscal Officer Welter reported that he has not received any invoices as of yet. Trustee Kuhn ask if Hawk gave us a quote. Road Worker Andy said that he originally said that the cost would be for \$275.00 per hour and that was for a whole crew. Trustee Distel said right now there is only one person working on it. Road Worker Andy said he had a resident complain

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about a catch basin on Glendale again. He said that we just cleaned it out a year ago. Road work Andy also talked to A&D on the 10th and showed him two spots of Township Road 130 and spot on 155. He said he would get us a quote. Road Worker Andy talked to Trustee Kuhn about some posts for Station two. They quote was \$158.00 plus shipping. Discussion was held on the type of post that was quoted.

Trustee McKinney reported that we did ask that guy to give us multiple quotes on jobs. Trustee McKinney reported that he has a college kid that is willing to work in the summer and help Andy when he needs a second set of hands. Trustee Distel said that this is just part time help which is what we have in the organizational meeting. Trustee Distel said he is good with that. Trustee Kuhn makes a motion to higher the college kid to work for the summer at \$17.50. Trustee Distel seconded. Mr. Kuhn Y, Mr. Distel Y, Mr. McKinney Y. Motion carried.

Trustee Kuhn reported he trimmed a branch on Township Road 201. Trustee Kuhn asked about the liquor permit fees. Fiscal Officer Welter reported that we receive liquor permit fees once a year.

Trustee Distel reported that he received a call from a Randy Swartz representing Jamie Bauman He said that all of the Vehicles are plated and running. He said he drove by the property and said that the vehicles have been moved.

Trustee Kuhn reported that the head lady at Autumnwood said that the tow truck is back and parking behind his house. Trustee McKinney said he is not parking on the street. Trustee McKinney said he is coming in on Autumnwood's private Drive to park behind his house. Trustee Kuhn said he told Crystal from Autumnwood that they need to call the Sherrieff.

Trustee Distel said the Honey Creek residents called him and asked where we were at. He asked the other trustees how they wanted to handle it. He asked if they wanted to have them come to a meeting or go out there and explain the drainage easement. Trustee Kuhn said when his work slows down, he is going to talk to the mayor about Cherry St. Trustee Distel said that he has spoken to the Engineer, the mayor, city engineer, soil and water. Everyone agrees that the Cherry St tile that we have is under sized that we could put a bigger tile in but we would just be pushing the problem down the road. Discussion was held on where the water runs.

Trustee Distel had talked to Matt Dysard. Matt Dysard was willing to donate land and put a retention pond in by Work Bench that would catch all the water that is going to that corner and slowly release it so you don't have all that backup. Discussion was held on how that would work. Trustee Distel reported he did get a call from Fabrizio and he said that they have way too much money setting on that land they are looking at the process of annexing into the city. If Clinton Township is not going to let them develop the land, they cannot just leave it sit there and get two hundred dollars a year farming. Trustee Distel said that if that happens, we will lose \$75,000 a year from lodging tax. Discussion was held on what else would be lost.

Trustee Distel said that the pot hole on Huron St. is all painted out see if you guys agree with how it is painted out and he will get it patched. Trustee Distel said he did get the revised estimates for all of the Cul-de-sacs that they were looking to fill in. He said that we received the information for next year's issue one projects.

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Trustee McKinney reported that on Township Road 15 during the last down pour the berm washed down the road. Discussion was held on what can be done.

Trustee Distel asked about the meeting with the prosecutor if they could go down to his office. Fiscal Officer Welter said he would check with him and see.
