

Clinton Township Board of Trustees – Regular Meeting

June 29, 2026 – 6:00 p.m.

The Following board members answered Roll Call Trustee Randy Kuhn, Trustee Jim Distel, Trustee William McKinney, and Fiscal Officer Steve Welter.

Guests: Dennis Kingseed, Andy Kimmet, Chris Hafley, Ray Bishop, and Craig Genet.

Trustee Kuhn asked everyone to recite the pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the regular meeting held on June 15th 2026 were read and approved.

Correspondence

Fiscal Officer Welter reported receiving an Email from Derek Devine that confirmed a meeting on July 9th at 1:15 at his office. Received an email from Marissa Bechstein that Lake Erie West will be conducting a study about Transportation, housing and work force engagement across our region. Email with a letter from Engineer Mark Zimmerman that Senecas county did not receive a road salt bid this year. ODOT held a second round with no bids. Entities will have to make other arrangements. Received two public records requests that had nothing to do with Clinton Township. Fiscal Officer Welter could not identify the bids that they were requesting. Received an Estimate from A&D Excavating. Received an Email from Craig Genet requesting to come to a meeting.

Chief Hafley reported this year the fire department responded to 327 runs last year 242 up 85 calls from last year. For the month May 6 calls in Eden township. 1 fire call in Clinton 2 mutual aid calls, 42 medical calls 4 accidents 3 service calls for a total of 51 calls. Chief Hafley reported that the AFG grant was submitted we will not find out results until October. Chief Hafley reported that we had two injuries at the last fire. One that went to the hospital and one that did not.

Dennis Kingseed asked what the meeting with Derek Devine pertains to. Trustee Distel said that it is about what was said at the zoning meeting. Zoning Inspector Hohman and Trustee Distel would like to verify what was said is true.

Craig Genet introduced himself and the Architecture firm out of Springfield Ohio that specializes in Fire Stations. Craig has moved back to Tiffin and his firm opened an office In Tiffin.

Road worker Andy reported he received the estimate from A&D. Road worker Andy said that they have an issue with a Tile on Township Road 132 house number 16. There is a corrugated Steel tile under the driveway and the bottom is rusted out. Discussion was held on how that is handled.

Trustee McKinney asked about Honey creek that was talked about at the last meeting. Trustee Mckinny reported that he and Road Worker Andy went out and looked at the Cherry St tile.

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Discussion was held on what was going on. Trustee McKinney reported that the State has a twelve-inch tile going into a twenty-four-inch township tile. The situation involves the State of Ohio, Clinton Township and the City of Tiffin since Cherry St is the city limits. Trustee Distel suggested contacting Soil and Water and get them involved to get it fixed right. Trustee McKinney asked if the new road estimates Issue one round 40 were forwarded to the auditor. Fiscal Officer Welter said he sent them to Julie Adkins and she forwarded them to Judy at Seneca County Collaborative who is now handling Issue One bids. Trustee McKinney reported that he and Road Worker went out and looked at Township Road 15 and thought they could put a catch basin in and an eight-inch tile so the berm will not wash out. Trustee McKinney reported that he called a company out of Perrysburg that does bulk Salt. They will be sending an estimate.

Trustee Distel reported that he and Road worker Andy and Trustee McKinney went out to Huron street and marked it out. Trustee Distel said that we would get it all ready and Lee Stover would pave and roll it for us.

Trustee McKinney asked about Township Road 201. It was determined to call Cliff Adams to have him work the two days he said he could do and then maybe call EZ Tree Service to finish up if needed.

Chief Hafley reported that the heating tube came loose again. Trustee Distel said that they should call Tiffin Deluxe and have them fix it.
